Summary

Provide consistent intercessory prayer support for all areas of Operation Christmas Child ministry. Actively engage in onsite prayer, personal intercessory prayer and corporate prayer for the local Area Team, local leadership team and all areas of Operation Christmas Child activity.

Primary Responsibilities

- Provide support for local Operation Christmas Child Area Team, and domestic Operation Christmas Child activities through personal intercessory prayer
- Meet with Prayer Team monthly for corporate prayer for Operation Christmas Child
- Participate regularly in intercessory prayer events (prayer walks, prayer drives, prayer meetings) and onsite prayer support for Area Team activities
- Participate in organised prayer coverage at Drop-off Location sites and commit to covering National Collection in prayer
- Participate in and promote special OCC prayer events including: 31 Days of Prayer, Days of Prayer and Fasting
- Serve as a Prayer Network Partner regularly praying for the ministry of OCC

Qualification

Spiritually mature Christian with strong interpersonal skills who is called to the ministry of prayer. Must be committed to the ministry goals of Samaritan's Purse/OCC. Must believe in the power of prayer and in the reality of spiritual warfare. Must be a minimum of 16 years of age to be selected into a position and serve on an Area Team. Parental consent is required for all volunteers under the age of 18.

Regular access to an individual email account and MyOCC is required.

Training Expectations

- Complete required in-person and online training
- Attend regional events and Area Team meetings
- Attend annual Connect Conference (encouraged)

Volunteer Time Commitment

- Ideally a volunteer term for a one year period.
- May require a time commitment up to 1 to 4 hours per week, possibly increasing during peak months.
- Volunteer role is re-evaluated annually and can continue by mutual agreement
